



INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSTRACT PRESENTERS IN E-POSTER SESSIONS

These instructions are related to ERS International Congress accepted abstract presenters in e-poster sessions.

E-posters sessions (former Thematic poster and Poster discussion) are built from abstracts published on the Congress platform in the e-poster format. They will be available 2 weeks before the event, ie. from 24 August. In E-poster sessions where two chairpersons are involved, a maximum of twenty abstracts are allocated in each session.

To fit the virtual format of the Congress programme, these sessions will not have a specific timeslot in the congress programme and there is no live discussion planned.

YOUR ROLE

- **Prepare** your e-poster in PDF format and upload it to the platform. Please include to your e-poster a voice recording of maximum 5 minutes. A link to upload your e-poster will be sent in July 2020. The e-poster and voice recording will be published on the Congress platform and will be available 2 weeks before the event, ie. from 24 August, so that chairs and participants can comment and ask questions about the abstracts.
- **Register** to the Congress in order to be able to read questions, comments and to interact with chairs of the session, as well as with participants.

- File format: PDF
- Recommended Pixels (minimum): 7680 width x 4320 height (landscape orientation, 16:9)
- Recommended size in cm (minimum): 65.0 width x 36.5 height (landscape orientation, 16:9)
